RECENT EVENTS

On Saturday, March 3, 2007 the MES organized a special **concert** featuring two of Estonia's master musicians, Urmas Vulp on violin and Heiki Mätlik on guitar. The highly-acclaimed classical duo made a rare concert appearance in Montreal, as part of their North American tour. The recital took place at Redpath Hall, McGill University, where more than 130 people were treated to a selection of music from several internationally-known Estonian composers, including Ester Mägi, Arvo Pärt, Eduard Tubin and Peeter Vähi. A wine and cheese followed, to which everyone was invited. The main sponsor for this event was Maurice Forget, C.M., Honorary Consul of Estonia in Montreal. Our thanks go to Karl J. Raudsepp for his meticulous organization.

The second annual **New Year's Eve Party** took place at the Annunciation Parish Hall in the Town of Mount Royal. Building on the previous year's success, there were over 75 people present, among them a contingent of revelers from Ottawa and elsewhere.
